**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOLLISTER
APPROVING THE TEMPORARY STREET CLOSURES FOR THE 2025 HOLLISTER
INDEPENDENCE RALLY**

WHEREAS, the Hollister City Council approved an agreement with Roadshows, Inc for operational management services for the 2025 Hollister Motorcycle Rally to be held on July 4 and 5, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Independence Rally will necessitate the use of public streets and areas for the public assembly of people and for the use of motorcycles and vendors; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department of the City of Hollister has deemed the street closures appropriate for the safety and protection of persons and motorcycles who are to use any portion of the streets during the temporary closing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Hollister hereby authorizes the following street closures to take place beginning on Thursday, July 3, 2025 at 7:00 am and ending Sunday, July 7, 2025 at 9:00 am to ensure the safety and protection of the public:

1. Closure of Fifth Street from Monterey Street to San Benito Street
2. Closure of Fifth Street from San Benito Street to East Street
3. Closure of Sixth Street from Monterey Street to San Benito Street
4. Closure of Sixth Street from San Benito Street to East Street
5. Closure of Seventh Street from Monterey Street to San Benito Street
6. Closure of Seventh Street from San Benito Street to East Street

The City Council of the City of Hollister further finds and determines that the following street closure shall be allowed beginning on Thursday, July 3, 2025 at 6:00 pm and ending Sunday, July 7, 2025 at 9:00 am to ensure the safety and protection of the public:

1. San Benito from Fourth Street to South Street
2. East Street from Fourth Street to South Street
3. Fifth Street from East Street to Sally Street
4. Swope Alley from Seventh Street to South Street

Said streets will be temporarily closed pursuant to Section 21101(e) of the Vehicle Code of the State of California. The City Council of the City of finds and determines that said closing is necessary for the safety of persons.

The Public Works Department will provide barricades to re-route traffic.

BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED, all times and street closures are subject to change at the City Manager's discretion.
