**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOLLISTER
CONSOLIDATING THE PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION,
ARTS AND CULTURAL COMMISSION, AND YOUTH COMMISSION
INTO A SINGLE COMMISSION AND ESTABLISHING OPTIONS FOR
COMMISSION STRUCTURE**

WHEREAS, the City of Hollister values public engagement and has historically maintained multiple advisory commissions to support community-focused services; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Commission, Arts and Cultural Commission, and Youth Commission have overlapping scopes, missions, and duties that can be more effectively served through a consolidated advisory body; and

WHEREAS, the consolidation of these commissions will enhance efficiency, encourage broader public participation, and allow for more integrated decision-making and recommendations; and

WHEREAS, this resolution does not preclude continued community input in areas of arts, youth, and recreational programming, but rather supports a unified approach.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. The Parks and Recreation Commission, Arts and Cultural Commission, and Youth Commission are hereby consolidated into a single Commission.
2. The Commission shall serve in an advisory capacity to the City Council and staff on matters related to:
 - Parks and recreational programming and facilities
 - Public art and cultural initiatives
 - Youth programs, events, and policy recommendations
3. The City Council shall determine the structure of the Commission as follows:
 - Membership: Five (5) or Seven (7) members, appointed by the City Council.
 - Meeting Frequency: Monthly or quarterly, as directed by Council resolution and included in the adopted bylaws.
4. Direct staff to return with amended bylaws, if necessary, and implement administrative changes to support the formation and operation of the Community Services Commission.
