**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOLLISTER
RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 2020-44 AND FORMALLY
DISBANDING THE CITY OF HOLLISTER DISASTER COUNCIL**

WHEREAS, on March 4, 2020, the State of California proclaimed a State of Emergency due to the threat of COVID-19 and issued Executive Order N-25-20; and

WHEREAS, in response, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2020-44 establishing the City of Hollister Disaster Council to address the public health emergency and facilitate expedited decision-making during a time of unprecedented operational challenges; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hollister Disaster Council was established as a temporary body under the authority granted by Chapter 2.36 of the Hollister Municipal Code and operated during the COVID-19 pandemic to coordinate emergency services and ensure the protection of life and property; and

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 public health emergency has officially concluded, and the City of Hollister has resumed normal operations and business procedures; and

WHEREAS, the continued operation of the Disaster Council is no longer necessary, and the powers and responsibilities delegated to it during the state of emergency have reverted to standard administrative procedures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. Resolution No. 2020-44 is hereby rescinded in its entirety.
2. The City of Hollister Disaster Council, created pursuant to Resolution No. 2020-44, is hereby formally disbanded
3. All powers and responsibilities previously granted to the Disaster Council shall return to their pre-emergency governance structures and standard operating procedures as defined in the Hollister Municipal Code and applicable state law.
