A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOLLISTER DECLARING THE INTENTION TO LEVY AND COLLECT ASSESSMENTS FOR LANDSCAPE AND LIGHTING DISTRICT NO. 93-1 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025/2026 AND SETTING THE PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF ASSESSMENTS FOR LANDSCAPE AND LIGHTING DISTRICT NO. 93-1 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025/2026 FOR JUNE 2, 2025 AT 6:30 P.M. IN CITY OF HOLLISTER'S COUNCIL CHAMBERS, 375 FIFTH STREET, HOLLISTER, CA 95203

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Hollister adopted Resolution No. 2025-051 initiating proceedings for the levy and collection of annual assessments for Landscape and Lighting District 93-1 ("District") pursuant to the provisions of the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972, Part 2 of Division 15 of the California Streets and Highways Code, commencing with Section 22500 ("Act") for the Improvements, Operation, Maintenance, and Services for street trees, parkways, perimeter sound wall, landscaping, hardscape, lighting and all appurtenant facilities and operations related thereto; and

WHEREAS, On April 21, 2025, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 202-051 initiating proceedings for the levy and collection of assessments within Landscape and Lighting District No. 93-1 for Fiscal Year 2025/2026 and ordered the City Engineer to prepare the required Engineer's Report and file it with the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer prepared the Draft Engineer's Report and filed it with the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, on May 5, 2025, the Draft Engineer's Report was approved by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Hollister wishes to continue the proceedings to levy and collect assessments for Landscape and Lighting District No. 93-1 for Fiscal Year 2025/2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Hollister, does hereby resolve as follows:

1. The City Council declares its intention to levy and collect assessments for Landscape and Lighting District No. 93-1 for Fiscal Year 2025/2026; and
2. The assessments are for operation, maintenance, and service costs of landscaping; lighting, street trees, park(s), parkway(s), storm water detention pond(s), sound wall(s), and appurtenant facilities described in the Engineer's Report for Landscape and Lighting District No. 93-1, Assessments for Fiscal Year 2025/2026; and

3. The Draft Engineer's Report, on file with the City Clerk, has a full and detailed description of the improvements; the boundaries of the Landscape and Lighting District No. 93-1 and Zones therein; and the proposed assessments upon the assessable lots and parcels of land within the District; and
4. The City Council will conduct a public hearing on the levy and collection of the assessments on June 2, 2025, at 6:30 p.m. in City of Hollister's City Hall Council Chambers, 375 Fifth Street, Hollister, CA, 95023; and
5. Notice of the public hearing shall be published in accordance with the California Streets and Highways Code Section 22626(a); and
6. The Fiscal Year 2025/2026 assessments do not increase the amount of the Fiscal Year 2024/2025 assessments.
