AGENDA ITEM: A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN UPDATED AIRPORT USE AGREEMENT WITH TRUWEATHER SOLUTIONS, INC TO PLACE ADVANCED WEATHER SENSOR INSTRUMENTS AT THE HOLLISTER MUNICIPAL AIRPORT

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Adopt a resolution approving an updated Airport Use Agreement with TruWeather Solutions, Inc. to place advanced weather sensor instruments at the Hollister Municipal Airport and authorizing the City Manager to execute the updated Agreement.

DISCUSSION: TruWeather Solutions, Inc. (TruWeather) desires to place two advanced weather sensor instruments at the Airport in support of advanced air mobility operations, to provide enhanced weather data for the Monterey Bay Tech Hub initiative supporting Electric Vertical Takeoff and Landing (“EVTOL”) and Unmanned Aerial Systems (“UAS”) operations in the regions and in support of the NASA Pathfinding for Airspace with Autonomous Vehicles (PAAV) project.

The Airport Use Agreement was presented for consideration and approved at the May 5, 2025, City Council meeting. Due to a miscommunication, the agreement presented at the May 5 meeting did not include the City Attorney office review. The updated Airport Use Agreement includes the City Attorney edits in track changes.

FISCAL IMPACT: TruWeather will pay for all costs associated with placing the advanced weather sensors on airport property and will pay the Airport \$100.00 per month for use of the facility/property.

PREVIOUS COUNCIL OR COMMISSION ACTION: At the regular meeting of May 5, 2025, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2025-57, approving an Airport Use Agreement with TruWeather Solutions, Inc. to place advanced weather sensor instruments at the Hollister Municipal Airport and authorizing the City Manager to execute the Agreement.
