AGENDA ITEM: A RESOLUTION OF INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO LEVY AND COLLECT ASSESSMENTS FOR LANDSCAPE AND LIGHTING DISTRICT NO. 93-1 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025/2026 AND SETTING THE PUBLIC HEARING

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Adopt a resolution declaring the intention to levy and collect assessments for Landscape and Lighting District No. 93-1 for Fiscal Year 2025/2026 and setting the public hearing by the City Council for the levy and collection of assessments for Landscape and Lighting District No. 93-1 for Fiscal Year 2025/2026 for June 2, 2025 at 6:30 pm in the City of Hollister's Council Chambers, 375 Fifth Street, Hollister, CA 95203.

DISCUSSION: On April 21, 2025, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2025-051, which initiated proceedings for the levy and collection of assessments within Landscape and Lighting District No. 93-1 for Fiscal Year 2025/2026 and ordered the City Engineer to prepare the required Engineer's Report and file it with the City Clerk.

The City Engineer prepared the Draft Engineer's Report and filed it with the City Clerk.

The City Council approved the Draft Engineer's Report dated May 5, 2025 by Resolution No. 2025-056.

The assessments are for operation, maintenance, and service costs of landscaping; lighting, street trees, park(s), parkway(s), storm water detention pond(s), sound wall(s), and appurtenant facilities described in the Engineer's Report for Landscape and Lighting District No. 93-1, Assessments for Fiscal Year 2025/2026.

The Draft Engineer's Report, on file with the City Clerk, has a full and detailed description of the improvements; the boundaries of the Landscape and Lighting District No. 93-1 and Zones therein; and the proposed assessments upon the assessable lots and parcels of land within the District.

A public hearing by the City Council will be conducted on the levy and collection of the assessments on June 2, 2025, at 6:30 p.m. in the City of Hollister's City Hall Council Chambers, 375 Fifth Street, Hollister, CA, 95023.

Notice of the hearing shall be published in accordance with Streets and Highways Code Section 22626(a). The Act requires a Resolution of Intention to be published in a local newspaper at least 10 days prior to the date of the public hearing. Staff will publish the Resolution of Intention in a local newspaper for the public hearing on May 16, 2025.

The Fiscal Year 2025/2026 assessments do not increase the amount of the Fiscal Year 2024/2025 assessments.

FISCAL IMPACT: The Draft Engineer's Report for Landscape and Lighting District No. 93-1, Assessments for Fiscal Year 2025/2026 estimates \$223,669.25 in revenue for Fiscal Year 2025/2026.

PREVIOUS COUNCIL OR COMMISSION ACTION: On May 5, 2025 the City Council adopted Resolution 2025-056 approving the Draft Engineers Report.

CEQA: This action does not constitute a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and review under CEQA is not required.
