**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOLLISTER
ACCEPTING A GRANT FROM THE OFFICE OF TRAFFIC SAFETY FOR
THE AMOUNT OF \$65,000.00 FOR OVERTIME REIMBURSEMENT AND
SPECIALIZED EQUIPMENT**

WHEREAS, the Hollister Police Department has applied for and received traffic safety grants from the Office of Traffic Safety for the last fourteen years; and

WHEREAS, these Selective Traffic Enforcement Programs (STEP) grants reimburse the City of Hollister for Police Officer overtime incurred while conducting extra patrol for traffic-related issues; and

WHEREAS, the types of extra patrol can include distracted driver enforcement when drivers are driving while using a cell phone for making calls or texting, seatbelt enforcement for drivers who drive without wearing a seatbelt, pedestrian safety patrols for vehicles that do not yield for pedestrians in the crosswalks, or bicycle safety enforcement; and

WHEREAS, a new grant has been awarded to the city, which will fund those mentioned activities as well as DUI checkpoints and DUI saturation patrols.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Hollister authorizes the Interim City Manager to accept a grant from the Office of Traffic Safety for the amount of \$65,000.00 for overtime reimbursement and specialized equipment.
