AGENDA ITEM: A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING BIDS AND AWARDING A CONTRACT TO SILICON VALLEY PAVING, INC. FOR THE AIRPORT OPERATIONS AREA PERIMETER FENCE RELOCATION PROJECT AT THE HOLLISTER MUNICIPAL AIRPORT

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Adopt a resolution accepting bids and awarding a contract to Silicon Valley Paving, Inc. of San Jose, California, for the airport operations area perimeter fence relocation project and authorizing the Interim City Manager to execute the agreement, change orders and any related documents.

DISCUSSION: The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) administers the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law Program (BIL) and the issuing of grants for eligible airport infrastructure and planning projects on an annual basis. The City identified its FAA designated Fiscal Year (FY) 2024-25 BIL project as the removal of and replacement of approximately 2,100 linear feet of the airport operations area (AOA) perimeter fence located north of Runway 6-24 and east of Runway 13-31.

The project will enhance airfield safety and bring the airport into compliance with FAA standards by: (i) relocating the airport's existing perimeter chain link fence outside of Runway 6/24 Object Free Area (OFA); (ii) similarly, relocate the airport perimeter vehicle service road outside of the Runway 6/24 OFA for the same length as the fence; and (iii) relocate the existing perimeter chain link fence outside of the Runway Visibility Zone (RVZ). The project will further demonstrate the City/Airport's continued efforts to meet its federal grant assurance of maintaining a safe and operable airfield

The City/Airport posted a bid notice on July 16, 2024, with a closing date of August 8, 2024. Six bids were received and reviewed by the Airport On-Call consultant Kimley-Horn. Kimley-Horn recommended Silicon Valley Paving, Inc. as the responsive low bidder with a bid of \$113,931.

At the regular meeting of October 15, 2024, the City Council adopted Resolution 2024-159 approving an application for and acceptance of a Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) Grant for relocation and replacement of a section of Airport Operations Area (AOA) fence. The FAA awarded the grant, AIG 03-06-0105-028-2025, on June 13, 2025, and the City executed the grant on June 16, 2025.

To execute the project, the City needs to award the construction contract to Silicon Valley Paving, Inc. in the amount of \$116,931 – the bid amount of \$113,931 plus \$3,000 due to material costs between bid submission and contract execution. Kimley-Horn will provide construction management & inspection services.

FISCAL IMPACT: The Airport AOA Perimeter Fence Relocation project is budgeted in the Federal Aviation Admin Grant Fund 212 for FY 2025-26. The total estimated project cost is \$150,431 with funding of FAA Grant amount, \$140,059 (95%) and Airport Enterprise Fund 601, \$10,372 (10%).
