AGENDA ITEM: A RESOLUTION OF INTENTION AND INTRODUCTION OF AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE A CONTRACT AMENDMENT WITH THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION OF THE CALIFORNIA PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

1. Adopt a Resolution of intention authorizing the City of Hollister to approve an amendment to the contract with CalPERS and authorizing the Mayor to sign.
2. Introduce an ordinance authorizing an amendment to the Contract between the City of Hollister and CalPERS.

DISCUSSION: The California Public Employees' Retirement System (CalPERS) maintains specific requirements with its contracts with agencies, including Hollister. In September, CalPERS notified the City that we are in need of amending our pension contract in order to incorporate the language reflecting the provisions outlined under the Public Employees' Pension Reform Act of 2013 (PEPRA). The City of Hollister, through this action, is working with CalPERS to ensure ongoing pension contract compliance.

FISCAL IMPACT: None – The taking of this action and amending the pension contract will not require a charge to the City.
