

SA RESOLUTION NO. 2026-XX SA

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOLLISTER, ACTING IN ITS CAPACITY AS THE SUCCESSOR AGENCY FOR THE CITY OF HOLLISTER REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY (RDA), TO ADOPT A RECOGNIZED OBLIGATION PAYMENT SCHEDULE (ROPS) FOR THE PERIOD OF JULY 1, 2026 TO JUNE 30, 2027

WHEREAS, Health and Safety Code section 34177(l)(2)(A) and (m) requires the Successor Agency to prepare and approve a Recognized Obligation Payment Schedule (ROPS) and make associated notifications and distributions for the period of July 1, 2026 to June 30, 2027; and

WHEREAS, the recognized obligation payment schedule was prepared using the forms provided by the California Department of Finance to the City Hollister Successor Agency; and

WHEREAS, Health and Safety Code Section 34177(k) requires the Successor Agency to prepare administrative cost estimates from the Successor Agency Administrative Budget and provide them to the Auditor-Controller for the County of San Benito; and

WHEREAS, the administrative budget includes costs associated with winding down the former RDA which helps defer costs associated with the existing non-housing loan agreement, and the Finance Department administration and Successor Agency Administrative Budget must be approved by the Oversight Board; and

WHEREAS, at a public meeting held on January 13, 2026, the Oversight Board approved the FY 2026-27 ROPS.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Hollister acting in its capacity as the Successor Agency of the former Hollister Redevelopment Agency (RDA) and in conformance with Health and Safety Code Section 34177(l) and (m), hereby approves the FY 2026-27 Recognized Obligation Payment Schedules (ROPS) for the period July 1, 2026 to June 30, 2027, the Successor Agency Administrative Budget, and the Successor Agency Administrative Cost Estimates; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council acting in its capacity as the Successor Agency of the former Hollister Redevelopment Agency (RDA), hereby authorizes and directs the Director or the Director's designee, acting on behalf of the Successor Agency, to file, post, mail, or otherwise deliver via electronic mail, internet posting, and/or hardcopy, all notices and transmittals necessary or convenient in connection with the approval of the ROPS, approval of the Successor Agency Administrative Budget, approval of the Successor Agency Administrative Cost Estimates and other actions taken pursuant to this resolution; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that nothing in this resolution shall abrogate, waive, impair or any other manner affect the right or ability of the City, as a municipal corporation, to initiate and prosecute any litigation with respect to any agreement or other arrangement between the City and the former RDA, including, without limitation any litigation contesting the purported invalidity of such agreement or arrangement pursuant to the Dissolution Act; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, approval of a Recognized Obligation Schedule is categorially exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act.
